We recognize the highly sensitive nature of immigration and legal DNA testing and are committed to maintaining strict confidentiality and ethical handling of all related information.

Information Collected

We may collect:

- Full legal name
- Date and place of birth
- Government-issued identification
- A-Number or USCIS case number (if applicable)
- DNA specimens and results
- Chain-of-custody documentation
- Legal and immigration-related records



Purpose of Collection

Information is collected exclusively for:

- Legal DNA testing
- Immigration DNA testing for USCIS cases
- Court-admissible identity verification
- Compliance with federal, court, and USCIS requirements

Disclosure

Information is disclosed only:

- To USCIS or U.S. embassies as required
- To courts, judges, or attorneys of record
- To accredited laboratories
- With written consent from the individual
- When mandated by federal law

We do not share immigration or legal DNA data for marketing or non-authorized purposes.

Ethical Standards

All legal and immigration DNA testing is conducted with:

- Verified identity
- Informed consent
- Strict chain-of-custody procedures
- Neutral, unbiased handling of results
